**SECOND EMERGENCY ORDER DUE TO HURRICANE IDA**

**IT IS ORDERED** that the 34<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court will continue to be closed from Tuesday, September 7, 2021 through Friday, September 10, 2021 for the safety of the public, our Judges and courthouse employees. St. Bernard Parish was in the path of Hurricane Ida which hit southeast Louisiana on August 29, 2021. The entire parish suffered damages and currently has power outages, as well as gas and food shortages, which creates a hardship for the public at large.

In concurrence with the Order of the Louisiana Supreme Court dated August 31, 2021, all time periods, limitations, and delays pertaining to the initiation, continuation, prosecution, defense, appeal, and post-conviction relief of any prosecution of any state or municipal criminal, juvenile, wildlife, or traffic matter within the Parish of St. Bernard are hereby suspended for a period of 30 days commencing from August 26, 2021.

Any and all preliminary or permanent injunctions, protective orders, temporary restraining orders, ex parte protective orders, and/or criminal stay away orders issued pursuant to R.S. 9:361 et seq., R.S. 9:372, R.S. 46:1846, R.S. 46:2131 et seq., R.S. 46:2151, R.S. 46:2171 et seq. R.S.46:2181 et. seq., Children’s Code Article 1564 et seq., code of Civil Procedure Articles 3604 and/or 3607.1, and/or Code of Criminal Procedure Articles 30, 320, and/or 871.1 which have been issued by this Court and which would expire on or between the dates of August 26, 2021 and September 12, 2021 are hereby **EXTENDED** for a period of (30) thirty days or until October 12, 2021, unless the matter is dismissed and/or a consent judgment is submitted prior thereto.


