COURT'S ENBANC ORDER OF DECEMBER 2021 RE: CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)


Acting under the authority of Article V, Section 1 of the Constitution of 1974, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the current state of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID – 19) in Louisiana, Governor John Bel Edwards' declaration of public health emergencies in Proclamation Number 25 JBE 2020, and extended in Governor Edwards' announcement on February 9, 2021 extending modified Phase 2 measures until March 2, 2021, and modified on May 25, 2021, in Proclamation Number 93 JBE 2021 and further modified in Proclamation Numbers 131 JBE 2021 and 132 JBE 2021 of July 21, 2021 and 133 JBE 2021 of July 23, 2021 as well as the most recent Proclamation Number 234 JBE 2021 of December 21, 2021 and in consideration of ongoing public health recommendations to reduce the risk of exposure to the virus and slowing the spread of the disease, including the ongoing distribution of vaccine, while balancing the need to protect the constitutional rights and public safety of the citizens of St. Bernard Parish by maintaining access to the 34<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. In accordance with the above, all individuals entering the St. Bernard Parish Courthouse shall be required to wear a mask that covers both the mouth and nose and social distancing shall be observed. All individuals entering the Courthouse may be pre-screened, which may include the taking of temperatures.
2. Only individuals with a scheduled in person court appearance or individuals needing to access courthouse offices shall be allowed to enter the courthouse. Necessary additional guests and/or witnesses shall be allowed access with authorization from the judge presiding.
3. Hallways and corridors shall be clear and are to be used for access only. Social distancing shall be observed.
4. Each courtroom shall be limited to the number of persons who can be accommodated while social distancing is enforced.
5. Criminal matters involving defendants who are incarcerated may continue to proceed via video conference.
6. All civil matters may proceed via video conferencing upon request, unless otherwise ordered by the court. Video conferencing shall not be video or audio recorded as it is not part of the official record. Virtual appearances shall not suspend any deadlines to submit: (a) Memoranda in support or opposition or reply, and/or (b) any other forms or documentation required for the parties' appearance.
7. This Order expressly does not prohibit any court proceeding by telephone, video conferencing, or any other means that do not involve in-person contact. This Order does not affect the court's consideration of matters that can be resolved without in-person proceedings.
8. Until further orders of the Court, no person shall bring any documents directly to any judge's office for signature ("walk-throughs"). In the event of an emergency order that is time sensitive, the court and the Clerk of Court shall be contacted to advise of same by the filer so that the court may make arrangements to execute same in a timely manner.
9. This Order expressly does not prohibit the presiding Judge from issuing orders regarding the handling of particular matters on their respective dockets.
